### **Profile**

I am a qualified Paediatric Nurse, registered with the Nursing and Midwifery Council and a member of the Royal College of Nursing, who graduated from Southampton University as a mature student in 2000.

Following admission to the nursing register, I worked in the acute specialties of paediatric cardiology, paediatric intensive care, and paediatric oncology.

In 2006 I transferred into the community, working for Clinovia Ltd and BUPA Home Healthcare delivering and managing the care of home ventilated children with complex care requirements. From 2008 I continued to work in this speciality for Thornbury Nursing Services, delivering nursing care and enabling children with complex healthcare needs to attend specialist or mainstream schools, working in partnership with families and other healthcare professionals to provide a comprehensive package of care, and supporting the child in order for them to reach their full potential.

I am familiar with many of the sophisticated pieces of equipment required to achieve these goals including overhead hoisting systems, multi-function electric wheelchairs, standing frames, cough assist devices and eye-gaze communication systems.

I have been working as a case manager since 2015, predominantly supporting children and young adults who have sustained catastrophic injuries, including spinal injuries and traumatic brain injuries.

I have comprehensive experience looking after children and young adults with many different clinical conditions, including cerebral palsy, spinal muscular atrophy, traumatic brain injury, congenital central hypoventilation syndrome, ADHD, spinal injuries, respiratory disorders, cardiac conditions, genetic or inherited disorders and those with Autism or Asperger syndrome.

My clinical skills include management of tracheostomy tubes, supportive ventilators, cough assist devices, percutaneous endoscopic gastrostomy tubes and MIC-KEY

buttons. I also have experience in elderly care, emergency adult medicine and orthopaedics, all gained during my nursing training. I have also spent time working on a voluntary basis with adult stroke and oncology patients. During the time I worked for Clinovia Ltd and BUPA Home Healthcare I was part of a team of nurses administering intravenous drug therapies and parenteral nutrition to a variety of patients in their own homes and I am familiar with the specific care requirements of this particular group.

I have excellent time management and communication skills and am able to work both independently or as an effective member of the wider multi-disciplinary team. I have comprehensive experience of working with colleagues in the statutory sector in order to maximise outcomes for the clients on my caseload.

As a case manager, I support a complex caseload of paediatric and young adult clients, many of whom require significant levels of care in their daily lives. I am experienced in managing both directly employed and agency care teams, with specific experience of helping to secure significant statutory funding through personal health budgets for my clients.

I have also worked as an expert witness for Jacqueline Webb Ltd, specialising in loss of service reports.
